## Presents: The QLD Green Tape Reduction Act - *What you need to know*

The *Environmental Protection (Greentape Reduction) and Other Legislation Amendment Act 2012* (<http://www.legislation.qld.gov.au/LEGISLTN/ACTS/2012/12AC016.pdf>) (Greentape Reduction Act) primarily amends the licensing framework under the EP Act and will come into force on 31 March 2013 .

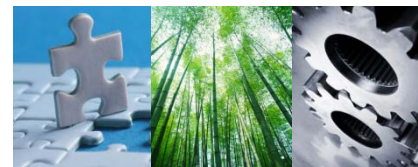
It aims to streamline, integrate and coordinate regulatory requirements under the *Environmental Protection Act 1994* (EP Act) without compromising environmental outcomes.

This presentation will cover what the proposed changes mean to those who currently undertaken an Environmentally Relevant Activity (ERA) and/or those that will be involved in applying for a new ERA Approval.

This will include:

- How the Greentape Reduction Act will impact on the licensing framework under the EP Act.
- The impact the Greentape Reduction project on regulatory standards and environmental outcomes.
- A description of the new approval process. Including standard, variation and site specific applications and how mobile and temporary activities will be affected.
- Suitable Operators
- Which activities the new approval process apply to.
- Transitioning into the new system.
- Managing your environmental authority
- Auditors framework

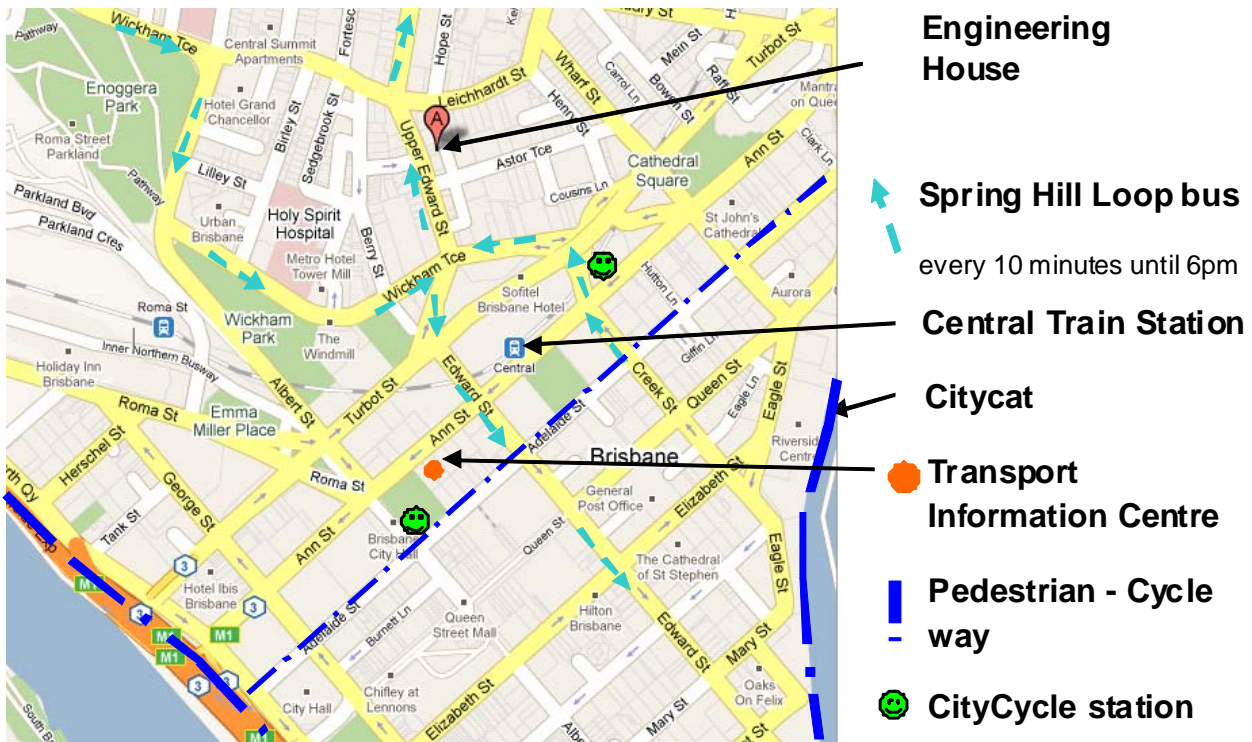
