### Starting to achieve real green

#### *Experiences in Living building Challenge, One Planet Living and the Zero Carbon Challenge*

Phillip and Anne will discuss ways sustainability is being progressed in the construction industry along with current project examples.

The Living Building Challenge goes beyond the usual rating tool and pushes the boundaries of sustainable design. Experience from working on one of the 4 Australian Projects (Sustainable Buildings Research Centre at the University of Wollongong) will be discussed.

One Planet Living allows projects, companies and communities to develop an operational plan for achieving sustainability and working towards this goal. A discussion about how this is being developed for the Cairns Entertainment Precinct project as well as other examples will be provided.

The 'Collaborative Future Team' won the Zero Carbon Challenge in March 2012. The competition commissioned by the South Australian Government was to design a zero carbon 3 bedroom home at the Lochiel Park Green Village in the suburbs of Adelaide.

As winners of the competition the team will now be granted a licence to build the house, with construction required to be completed before December this year. The media attention has been huge including an approach from Grand Designs.

The presentation will count as one hour towards your CPD.

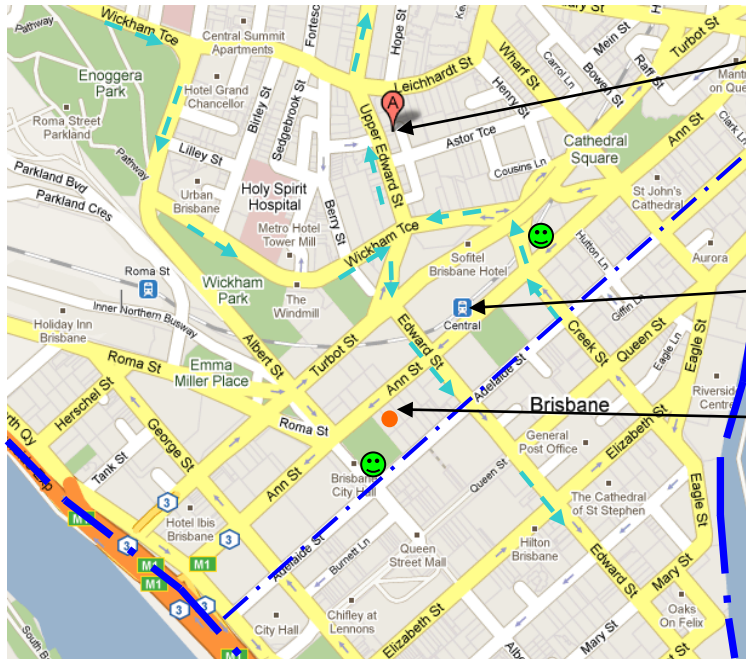
